Remember some of our seniors who are homebound, drop a card or give them a call, to let them know we have not forgotten them.

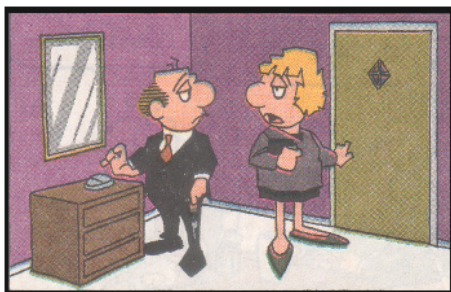


Mission Project for Diane Laws: (works/lives in Lele, Kosrae, Micronesia)
